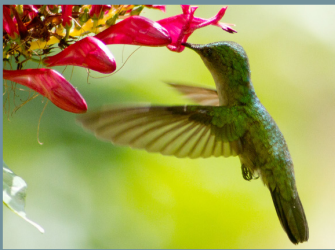


Hummingbird Care Quick Guide



Nectar Recipe Guide

1. Recipe calls for 4 parts water to 1 part white sugar (Example: 1 cup water:1/4 cup sugar).
2. Boil water. If microwaving use glass to avoid microplastics.
3. Mix sugar with water. Only use white sugar.
4. Let cool. Refrigerate excess for later use.

Important: Never use dyes in your nectar. Refresh twice a week.



Cleaning Guide And Tips

- Regular feeder cleaning is important. Sugar, water, heat and sun make excellent conditions for harmful microbial growth.
- Clean weekly. Clean twice a week during hotter weeks.
- Use soap and water. Wipe off grime thoroughly as you wash.
- Rinse thoroughly.
- Cleaning nectar ports is critical. Use pipecleaners as shown.



Suction Feeder Guide

- Before placing your feeder, clean the window thoroughly and let dry.
- Clean the suction cups on your feeder. Debris will break seals.
- To achieve good suction, add the slightest bit of oil to your finger. Rub your finger around the rim of the suction cups to strengthen the seal.
- Temperature changes may cause seals to break and feeders to fall.
- Do not hang high. Falls from taller heights lead to breakage.
- Feeders hanging over hard ground surfaces may break if they fall.
