

Hummingbird Care Quick Guide



Nectar Recipe Guide

- 1. Recipe calls for 4 parts water to 1 part white sugar (Example: 1 cup water:1/4 cup sugar).
- 2. Boil water. If microwaving use glass to avoid microplastics.
- 3. Mix sugar with water. Only use white sugar.
- 4. Let cool. Refrigerate excess for later use.

Important: Never use dyes in your nectar. Refresh twice a week.

Cleaning Guide And Tips

- Regular feeder cleaning is important. Sugar, water, heat and sun make excellent conditions for harmful microbial growth.
 - Clean weekly. Clean twice a week during hotter weeks.
 - Use soap and water. Wipe off grime thoroughly as you wash.
- Rinse thoroughly.
- Cleaning nectar ports is critical. Use pipecleaners as shown.





Suction Feeder Guide

- Before placing your feeder, clean the window thoroughly and let dry.
- Clean the suction cups on your feeder. Debris will break seals.
- To achieve good suction, add the slightest bit of oil to your finger. Rub your finger around the rim of the suction cups to strengthen the seal. Temperature changes may cause seals to break and feeders to fall.
- Do not hang high. Falls from taller heights lead to breakage.
- Feeders hanging over hard ground surfaces may break if they fall.
